At this meeting we will provide information on room parent responsibilities, the calendar for the year, and other information. Bring your calendar so that you can sign up for the session dates of your choice. Room parent activities may include setting up or cleaning up for each class, bringing flowers, cutting figures, photocopying, or other tasks.

Additionally, there are two more major opportunities to help out and step behind the curtain: **Atria Set Up Days (week of October 8)** and **Family Work Days (last week in May)**. Due to a Knights of Columbus event this fall, the time available for set up is very compressed. We will need help with cleaning items, trays, wiping shelves, fixing broken items/furniture, washing rugs, painting shelves, etc.
